DIRECTIONS TO PONTISPOOL: From junction 25 or 26 of the M5, follow the signs for Taunton, Wiveliscombe & Norton Fitzwarren. Pass through Norton Fitzwarren on the B3227 & follow the brown horseshoe tourist signs to Pontispool.

DRESSAGE TESTS: The Dressage takes place on grass & tests are available to download from: http://www.pcuk.org/index.php/sports/dressage/dressage_tests/ Class 1 may be commanded.

SHOW JUMPING: Show Jumping will take place on the all-weather arena and is not timed

CROSS COUNTRY; The xc course will be ready to walk from 2pm on Friday.

Class 1 & 2 – xc optimum time is based on 435mpm but no penalties incurred for going too slowly although penalties will be awarded for going too fast. At all levels completing the course in more than 15 seconds under the Optimum Time incurs 0.4 penalties for every second commenced. No stopwatches allowed.

Class 3 – xc optimum time is based on 450 mpm with 0.4 penalty points incurred for every commenced second over the optimum time. Penalties will also be awarded for going too fast. Completing the course in more than 15 seconds under the Optimum Time incurs 0.4 penalties for every second commenced. Stopwatches are allowed for Class 3

Rules of Competition

The competition will be run in accordance with Pony Club eventing rules 2021 which can be viewed at <https://pcuk.org/officials/rulebooks/>

1. All competitors compete at their own risk.
2. Horses may be entered only once & a maximum of 3 horses per rider
3. No horse may compete at both the SOVRC event on Saturday 5th June and the Silverton Pony Club event on Sunday 6th June
4. All horses and ponies coming to this event must have a current in date Flu vaccination certificate available for inspection with the most recent booster within the last twelve months.
5. All heights are approximate.
6. If you are disqualified in the dressage or SJ you will not be allowed to go cross country unless the express permission of the chief steward is granted.
7. No entries accepted without the correct fee.
8. Late Entries will only be taken if there is space.
9. The Judge or Committee's decision is final in all matters.
10. Whilst every effort has been made to ensure the safety of horses, riders & persons present the SHPC cannot be held responsible for any accident however caused.
11. Hats & Body Protectors **must** conform to current PC standards & hats must have the current aquamarine tag in place. Medical Armbands are recommended & body protectors are compulsory for xc. Hats tags will be checked at each phase.
12. All dogs to be kept on leads at all times.
13. The organiser reserves the right to alter the schedule, refuse any entry, eliminate any competitor not adhering to the rules, alter the course before or during the competition, alter the advertised times, cancel any class or section, divide any class & transfer competitors between sections.
14. Classes may not run in order.
15. Horses & Ponies must be at least 5 years old & must have a valid passport. Failure to produce the horse passport for identity or vaccination checks will result in all horses in that vehicle being asked to leave the venue.
16. Practice jumps must be approached from the direction indicated (red flag on right).
17. Pony Club members are no longer required to produce a spur certificate.
18. Stop watches are allowed to be worn at PC90, PC100 & PC110 Levels but not at PC80 or below
19. Objections must be made in writing to the Secretary's Office with a £10 deposit & within 15 minutes of the incident. The deposit will be refunded if the objection is sustained.
20. Withdrawals to be made via email to info@horse-events.co.uk
21. Withdrawals on the day to be made by telephone or text to 07711 623381
22. **75% refund before the closing date. No refunds after the closing date unless we can replace your entry from the waitlist in which case 75% of the entry fee will be refunded.**
23. Changing both horse & rider in the same entry qualifies as a new entry & must be paid in full.
24. If you would like to edit your horse or rider details before the closing date of the event please login to your Horse Events account and edit your booking under the 'MY BOOKING' Tab
25. If you would like to change the class please email info@horse-events.co.uk and if there is space available they will do this for you.
26. For ALL changes of horse and rider substitutions after the closing date there is a £5 charge please fill out the following form online at: <https://www.horse-events.co.uk/rider-horse-substitutions-form/>
27. In case of abandonment or cancellation info will be posted on the Silverton Pony Club website <https://silvertonhuntpcblogger.wordpress.com/> and Facebook pages or ring organiser – 07711 623381. If the competition has to be abandoned or cancelled by the organisers 50% of the entry fee will be refunded.

EHV-1 - As agreed with all British Equestrian Member bodies, we are required to ask all competitors to complete an EHV-1 form which is an ongoing biosecurity measure to protect our equines and mitigate the risk of spreading this infectious condition. The form should be completed for each horse attending the Competition. The EHV-1 Self Declaration form will be available when the times are published on www.ponyclubresults.co.uk and should be completed by the rider or owner of the horse and submitted online 24 hours before arrival at the competition.

COVID RULES

Please can we draw your attention to the following points which have been put into place to ensure your safety whilst we continue to run competitions according to Pony Club COVID-19 protocol. These may be subject to change depending on Government guidelines at the time and any further advice will be issued when times are published.

- Upon arrival you will be checked in & numbers will be strictly limited to two supporters per combination & no additional spectators. This should only be from a maximum of 2 households. Any Children Under 11 years old living in the same household as the rider will be allowed onsite. (Children under 11 are not counted in the supporting people numbers) Your supporting person must be available to help the rider alongside medical staff in the event of an accident if required. Additional drivers of lorries or trailers are counted as your supporting people.
- Parking must be a minimum of 5m apart.
- There will be a secretary's tent on-site but for advice & guidance only. All times will have been published prior to the event & competitors need to print or write their own numbers as large as possible on two pieces of A4 paper to slot into their own BE style bib
- No parents or coaches to enter the SJ warm-up area. We will make a steward available to set the practice jumps.
- Times must be adhered to.
- Please follow any one-way systems in place & do not stop to chat or loiter.
- Having completed each phase please return to designated parking area to untack as quickly as possible.
- Having finished the event & seen to your horse or pony please load up & head home as soon as possible.
- Dressage sheets can be scanned & sent to either your mobile number or email address if requested
- No prize-giving will take place on the day & all results will be posted online. Rosettes will be posted following the competition but are available to collect on the day 10 minutes after result are published if you are still onsite.
- Social distancing should be adhered to maintaining a 2m distance between competitors at all times
- Competitors & supporters should wash/sanitise hands regularly.
- Competitors are reminded that the use of face masks can help to reduce the spread of infection & are encouraged to wear them, but this is not mandated.
- On site catering will be available outside for take-away foods only. Social distancing must be maintained throughout the purchasing & consumption of any food & drink.

British Connemara Pony Society's (BCPS) Eventing Championships

In order to compete at the British Connemara Pony Society's (BCPS) Eventing Championships the owner of the pony needs to be an Adult/Junior or Performance Member of the British Connemara Pony Society. Ponies must be pure, part-bred or overheight Connemaras, which are registered or overstamped on the BCPS database. The pony must be in the correct ownership.
